### Special notes:

- Check-In
  - o The team discussed what was needed and how they were feeling going into Spring 2025.
    - Ray
      - Worried about the freshmen and their understanding of arrhythmias.
    - Halley

- Worried about freshmen cohort being slightly behind in the lab course.
  - o Plans on working on catheter control and exchange this semester.
- Worried about the senior cohort for clinic.
  - Majority of the students will be starting clinic late (1/16) except the students at TGH.
  - o Clemencia
  - o Leah (behavior)
    - Starts clinic on 1/15
- We are working on securing another photographer for class pictures this semester.
  - Halley is waiting to hear back from her contacts.
- Lena announced that she will be resigning her position effective January 31st, 2025.
  - She is working to get Halley's position changed to a Program Coordinator position and to have someone hired before she leaves. She is open to helping make sure the transition is smooth. She will be present for the advisory board meeting and pinning ceremony.
- Clinic
- Majority of the students are starting clinic late.
- We have not heard back from Lakewood Ranch or Florida Heart Associates.
- The hotel has been booked for Madison and Michelle.

- Inventory & Equipment Updates
  - Ordering more IV poles.
  - Team discussed ordering contrast and stated that using it would damage the manifolds that we have, so the students are better off using water.
- Non-Invasive Program
  - Grant from FutureMakers was not approved. The administration is taking it to the state for funding. We will know something in July.
  - Curriculum was approved for both programs.
    - Microbiology and Medical Terminology will be removed as required courses and course hours will increase for CVT 2420, 2421, 2840L, 2841L.
- CVT Advisory Board Meeting & Pinning Ceremony
  - The meeting will be held on Thursday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025 in A 207. The pinning ceremony will be on Friday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Due to construction, the AA 177 room will not be available for use so we will need to use another space.
