
SPAS Updates – SPAS Course Refresh Program





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

President's Priorities!

Succession planning and mentoring.

Succession planning is a process and strategy for replacement planning or passing on leadership roles. It is used to identify and develop new, potential leaders who can move into leadership roles when they become vacant. Seasoned leaders will be used as mentors and coaches.

Increasing enrollment and improving graduation rates.

Increase enrollment by determining obstacles that keep students from: completing the admissions process, enrolling after admitted, re-enrolling, returning after they have stopped out and removing these obstacles – ultimately increasing the # of students who graduate.*

Creating centers of excellence.

Develop institutes and centers that distinguish FSW. Among other goals, the centers and institutes will be vehicles for external funding and will create training in their particular area so that FSW will become a destination for others to come and train on this campus.






Academic Affairs Organizational Chart





Instructional Method	Description	Location
FSW Online	In an FSW Online course all of your instruction and coursework occurs through Canvas, and you are not required to attend any scheduled class meetings. Instructors may offer optional synchronous meetings, but not require them. ProctorU or Proctorio or "Alternate Testing Location"	Online Only
FSW Live Online	FSW Live Online courses are a special version of an online course where instruction occurs via Zoom during a regularly scheduled time. ProctorU or Proctorio or "Alternate Testing Location"	Online Only
FSW Blended Online	In an FSW Blended Online course you will meet in a virtual Zoom classroom for some class meetings and also be required to complete coursework delivered online through Canvas. You do not have to come to campus. ProctorU or Proctorio or "Alternate Testing Location"	Online Only
FSW Blended On Campus	In an FSW Blended On Campus course your professor will mix required on campus class meetings with online coursework. The online portion of the course may be live in a virtual Zoom classroom or all asynchronous in Canvas. Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services or ProctorU or Proctorio (optional)	A mix of both
FSW Traditional	In an FSW Traditional course you will be expected to meet on an FSW campus on a regular weekly schedule. Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services	On Campus Only
FSW Live Flex	In an FSW Live Flex course, you choose how you attend each class. You can opt to come to campus for every class, join virtually by Zoom every class, or a mix that fits your needs. The class will always meet together at regularly scheduled times, but some classmates will be attending virtually. Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services or ProctorU or Proctorio (optional)	A mix of both




