SPAS Updates for Fall – The end is near!

Attached is a detailed copy of our “End of Term” Procedures file, which we try to keep updated. Check that out for complete details of our normal grade processing requirements. Below are a few highlights:

- **Check your FSW email and contact phone number every day from the start of final exams week to the day of the deadline, even if you think you’re finished. Please make sure you have a working number and that the voicemail is not full.**
- Any student receiving an F also requires a last date of attendance. For ground classes, that is the last day they attended class; for online students you can use the last day they submitted an assignment.
- If you’ve agreed to give a student an Incomplete, make sure that an “I” is their reported grade and that you give their last date of attendance.
- After the deadline, the only way to submit grades will be filling out Change of Grade forms on workflow for **each** missing student.
- Grades roll nightly – after that, changes need to be made through the Change of Grade form

SPAS Updates – Spring

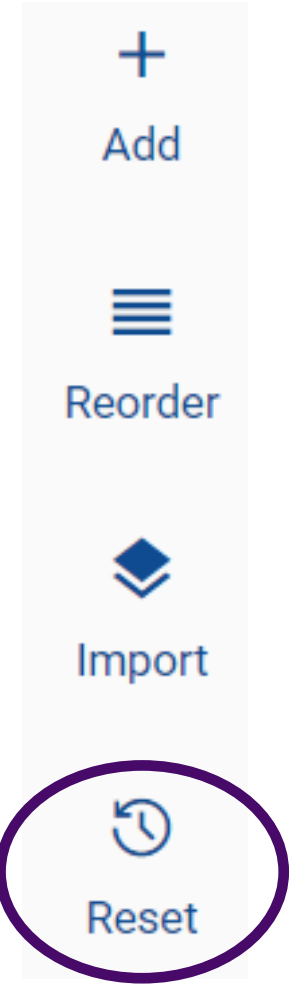
- Automatic Attendance Verification

- We are going through the final processes required in Banner to get the system set up for Spring – we'll let you know as soon as the project is ready.
- ***Assuming all goes well***, information and training will be coming in December and during the duty week in January.
- Assignments required will be in lock module. They will be worth 0% of the course grade – so you will not have to manage the assignment(s), and they will not effect your course grades.
- We will ask you to encourage and message students to complete the assignments in the first week of class as normal.
- **I strongly recommend you to turn all of the current attendance verification assignments into course orientations assignments and retain them as part of your courses – especially for any course with an online component or using a secondary LMS such as MyLabs.**



SPAS Updates – Spring

- Simple Syllabus – Spring Syllabi are due
 - **Spring Syllabi are due to your Department Chair on Saturday, December 2 (the last day of classes).**
 - This is the first “roll” of syllabi from a previous semester – if something rolls weird, please let us know.
 - Spring syllabi will pull data from both the master syllabus and your fall syllabus – you can reset to the master syllabus by resetting any section *and only that section* using the reset function.
Example: If your syllabus imports the textbook section from both your previous term and the master syllabus, you can fix that by resetting just the “Required Course Materials” section.





SPAS Updates – Reminders

Nominations are now open for:

Faculty Teaching and Instruction Excellence Award - recognizing full-time faculty who have exceeded the expectations for Teaching and Instruction.

College and Community Service Excellence Award - recognizing full-time faculty who have exceeded the standards for College and Community Service.

Professional Development and Scholarship Excellence Award - recognizing full-time faculty who have exceeded the standards for Professional Development and Scholarship.

Recipients of these faculty excellence awards will be recognized at a ceremony in January. Each awardee will receive a plaque and a framed certificate in addition to having their name forwarded to the National Institute for Staff and Organizational Development (NISOD) for national recognition. Additionally, each recipient will be funded to represent FSW at the annual NISOD International Conference on Teaching and Learning Excellence in Spring 2024.

Students, faculty, staff, and administrators are all welcome to [submit nominations](#) for these awards.

Deadline for nominations: November 27, 2023

- Mathematics Department Chair nominations are due to the Dean by December 1
- Let the Dean know if you have any online course development requests that are not already part of the course refresh plan
- Research reassign time requests due January 15, 2024
- IGCC interviews should be complete, and Continuing Contract Faculty due for portfolio reviews should all have received their Canvas Shells
- **If you need to complete the online “boot camp” training, please do so ASAP! (and I recommend giving it a try even it isn’t required for you!)**
