



SPAS Updates – Course Refresh Plan



Working to get our courses in alignment with the contract requirements

There have been some shifting philosophies over the last few years – current plan is focused on Departmental courses and the QM rubric.

- **Departmental Courses** Terminology for "Master Shells" I am working to submit the next round of requests for developmental courses, giving priority to the development date of the last "master shell", results of any internal 5-year reviews, and the number of faculty teaching the course. I should be reaching out over the next few weeks to start getting those requests submitted.
- Retro Courses -- eLearning has reached out about courses that have been completed within the last two years and offering to make them departmental masters. I have started reaching out to the current owners of those courses.

Assessments!

A huge thanks to Tina and the course coordinators for working on the assessment reports – there are some great new assessments tools being created.

Biggest questions I hear is about common final exams – I believe that common final exams are important and can help maintain course standards and increase the level of consistency across all sections of a course (particularly those offered across many modalities and taught be a variety of faculty (full-time, adjunct, concurrent). They are probably not, however, the best tool for a course assessment.



SPAS Updates — Summer & Fall (Repeats from 1 Feb Update)



Summer and Fall Teaching Assignments:

Gus actively working on creating the summer of fall teaching assignments and is scheduled to have drafts out for faculty confirmation by the end of February. You might start seeing Canvas shells pop up – those are drafts in Banner, and will be complete once they come out of scheduler with a confirmed room and time, and you all review them!

Textbook Adoptions for Summer

Textbook adoptions for Summer are due from the course coordinators to **Andy by Feb 29**th. We will be using Follett to adopt our textbooks and don't expect many changes from Spring, but please confirm all information with both faculty and publishers.

Textbook Adoptions for Fall

Textbook adoptions for Fall are due from the course coordinators to **Andy by Mar 28**th. We will be using BibliU to adopt our textbooks and will be using a whole new system. BibliU info will be integrated into Canvas, and we are requesting the use of first day/inclusive access where feasible – which will require new ISBNs even if the textbook information is the same. Many more details to follow
