SPAS Updates – BibliU!



- Inclusive Access vs Print
 - All SPAS courses that require material are now in inclusive access except Labster
 - OER course all excluded – continue to provide through Canvas
 - MCB – textbook inclusive access, lab manual (print or Labster) through bookstore
- Three types of Inclusive Access
 - ebook: Retrieved in BibliU library - material will be accessed through BibliU/course materials link in Canvas
 - Courseware with Access Codes: Retrieved in BibliU library, redeemed on publisher site - Codes will be accessed through BibliU/course materials link in Canvas
 - Courseware with LTI/Deep integrated Courseware: Material will be accessed via a direct link to the publisher in the Canvas Course

- Students - FL law says students have right to record class lectures (and only class lectures) for personal use **only** (they are not allow to post or share with classmates)
- Faculty – if leverage for meetings, make sure participants are aware, and don't share sensitive data with AI.

Adjunct Review Process 24-25

Shorter, annual process vs Detailed three year process

Canvas course:

- Upload Student Opinion Survey for all classes
- Upload Student Success Data,
- Upload Observation form (New Adjuncts, DE Faculty annually, or every three year as needed)
- Reflection on the teaching semester
- Set goals for the following year.

Still Need Mentors!

- Chair/Director to identify mentors for New FT Faculty, new Adjuncts, and DE Faculty. (Note: Mentors must have completed Mentoring Matters Training) – **August 2024**
- Adjuncts upload their required materials no later than 2/14/25.

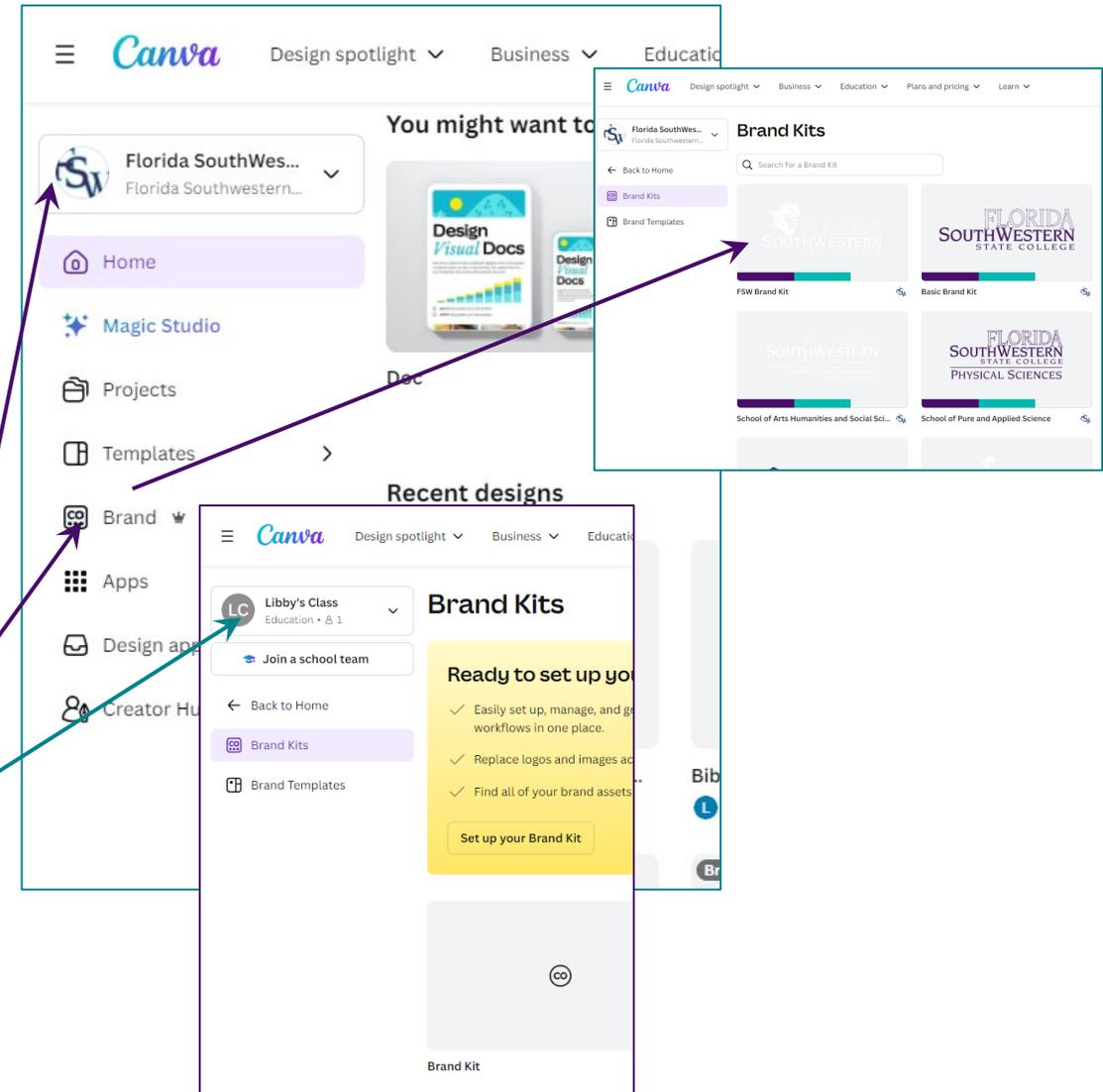
All faculty have access to Canva with FSW SSO

FSW Online		<p>In an FSW Online course all of your instruction and coursework occurs through Canvas, and you are not required to attend any scheduled class meetings. Instructors may offer optional synchronous meetings, but not require them.</p> <p>ProctorU or Proctorio or “Alternate Testing Location”</p>	Online Only
FSW Live Online		<p>FSW Live Online courses are a special version of an online course where instruction occurs via Zoom during a regularly scheduled time.</p> <p>ProctorU or Proctorio or “Alternate Testing Location”</p>	Online Only
FSW Blended Online		<p>In an FSW Blended Online course you will meet in a virtual Zoom classroom for some class meetings and also be required to complete coursework delivered online through Canvas. You do not have to come to campus.</p> <p>ProctorU or Proctorio or “Alternate Testing Location”</p>	Online Only
FSW Blended On Campus		<p>In an FSW Blended On Campus course your professor will mix required on campus class meetings with online coursework. The online portion of the course may be live in a virtual Zoom classroom or all asynchronous in Canvas.</p> <p>Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services or ProctorU or Proctorio (optional)</p>	A mix of both
FSW Traditional		<p>In an FSW Traditional course you will be expected to meet on an FSW campus on a regular weekly schedule.</p> <p>Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services</p>	On Campus Only
FSW Live Flex		<p>In an FSW Live Flex course, you choose how you attend each class. You can opt to come to campus for every class, join virtually by Zoom every class, or a mix that fits your needs. The class will always meet together at regularly scheduled times, but some classmates will be attending virtually.</p> <p>Testing Center for Make-up Exams and Adaptive Services or ProctorU or Proctorio (optional)</p>	A mix of both

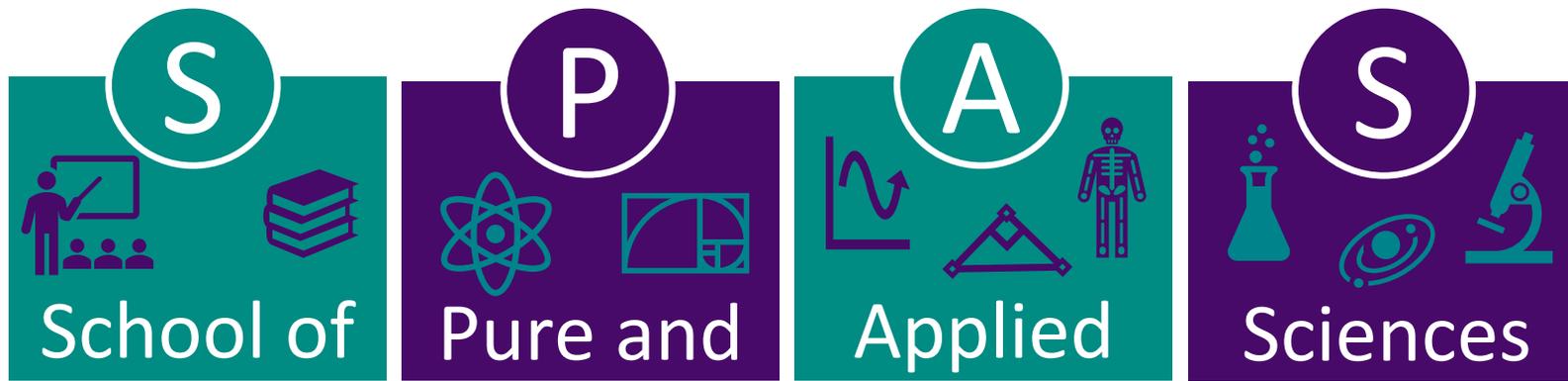
