# End of Semester (new)

Attached is a detailed copy of our “End of Term” Procedures file, which we try to keep updated. Check that out for complete details of our normal grade processing requirements. Below are a few highlights:

- **Check your FSW email and contact phone number every day from the start of final exams week to the day of the deadline, even if you think you’re finished. Please make sure you have a working number and that the voicemail is not full. Please answer if Andy calls – he actively monitors the list starting on the afternoon of the 9th!!**
- Any student who earned an F also requires a last date of attendance. For ground classes, that is the last day they attended class; for online students you can use the last day they submitted an assignment. If there is a date already loaded you should be able to delete it and then enter a new date.
- If you’ve agreed to give a student an Incomplete, make sure that an “I” is their reported grade and that you give their last date of attendance.
- After the deadline, the only way to submit grades will be filling out Change of Grade forms on workflow for **each** missing student.
- Grades roll nightly – after that, changes need to be made through the Change of Grade form
- Don’t forget page 2! Best practices recommend setting the view to “all” before entering grades so you don’t forget the second page or have issues saving when moving to page 2.

**Grades are due December 10th at NOON**

- Inclusive Access vs Print
  - All SPAS courses that require material are now in inclusive access except Labster
  - OER course all excluded – continue to provide through Canvas
  - MCB – textbook inclusive access, lab manual (print or Labster) through bookstore
- Three types of Inclusive Access
  - ebook: Retrieved in BibliU library - material will be accessed through BibliU/course materials link in Canvas
  - Courseware with Access Codes: Retrieved in BibliU library, redeemed on publisher site - Codes will be accessed through BibliU/course materials link in Canvas
  - Courseware with LTI/Deep integrated Courseware: Material will be accessed via a direct link to the publisher in the Canvas Course

  - For section level OER adoptions, please make that block not visible as you update your course materials to be different from the adopted course level materials

## 12 Week Terms

Implementing for FALL 2025

- Open to all students at half capacity so balance of students registering early/late
- 12 week to match summer terms to build on prepared course shells
- Focus on Core Gen Eds for FTIC students
- Avoid the “Catch up” challenges to promote student success
- Open more traditional options for late applicants
- Better option for 4 credit hr classes than B terms?
- Consistent with what most other schools are currently offering

**Video Platform:** A new video platform called Yuja is being considered.

- The main concern is migration, but if we decide to switch, all videos and deep links will transfer seamlessly, so nothing will be lost.
- The key question is: Should we stick with Kaltura or move to Yuja? Before making this decision, Kaltura will be hosting a demo on October 25th at 11 am. If you're interested, please also take the time to watch the Yuja demo.

**Remote Proctoring:** Honorlock, a “new to FSW” remote proctoring platform, is now under consideration.
