Dr. Nate Southerland, experienced HLC on-site reviewer, who is currently serving as Provost at Santa Fe College in Gainesville, FL, will be on Lee Campus (with Zoom-room links provided to other campuses) to provide us all with informative sessions that include a "mock" HLC question and answer period that will include a mini-dress rehearsal of what to expect when our visiting team arrives.

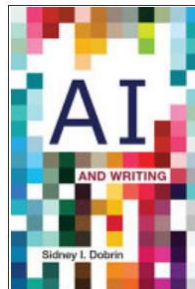

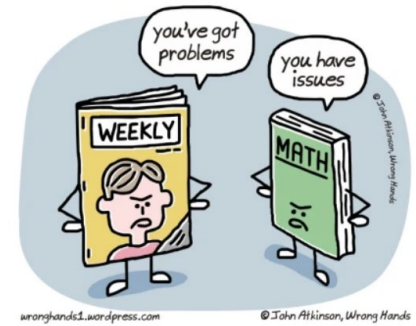

Those needing robes can rent them from the bookstore – details to follow as well.

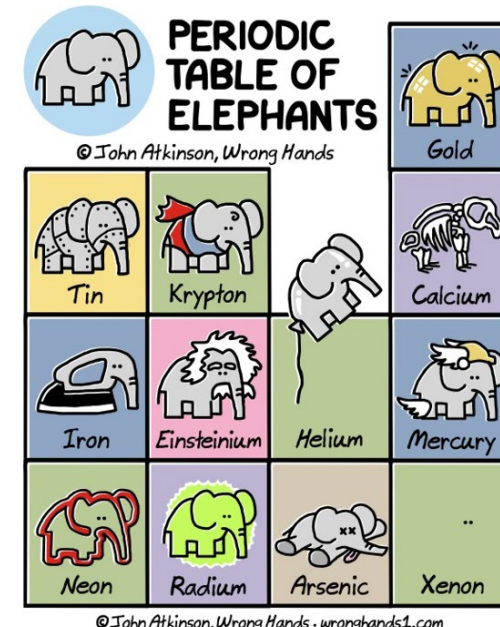

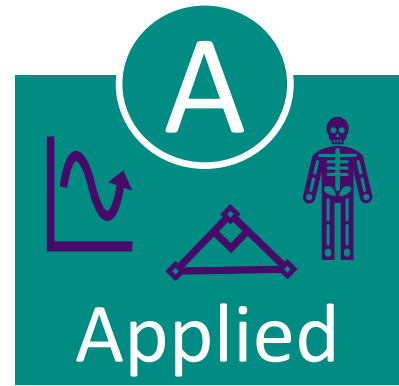
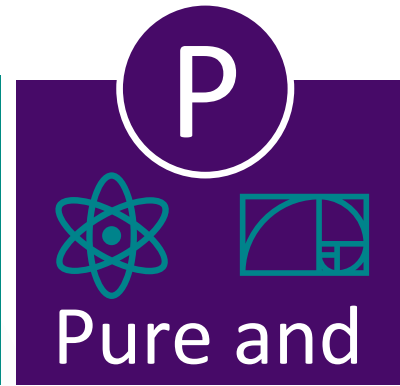
