- 3. Alisa will invite Mara Morrell from FSW to our next department meeting to explore what type of marketing materials we want for Business/Accounting. Here are some thoughts/suggestions:
 - Print Materials brochures, flyers, posters (high schools), postcards
 - Digital Marketing social media campaigns to share student testimonials, program highlights, and
 career outcomes, email newsletters with program updates, events, and success stories, website
 content with faculty bios, and search engine optimization. Also, create online quizzes like "Is a Career in
 Business Right for You?" to engage prospective students or offer virtual tours of K Building and our
 offerings.
 - Video Content student testimonials and program overview videos that highlight the curriculum, faculty, and facilities or day in the life videos that may show what it's like to be a student in our program.
 - Content Marketing blog posts by writing articles on topics like "Top Careers in Accounting" or "Why
 Study Business at FSW", share stories of successful alumni or innovative projects by students, or offer
 free resources like "How to Start a Career in Accounting" to attract prospective students.
