- Equipment and Supply needs
 - Isimulate Accessories replacement parts: ekg cables, sp02 sensors, bp cuffs, and pads.
 - IO trainers for skills
 - Stretcher batteries
 - IO kits replacements: more IO needles and peripherals
 - Pre-made moulage kits for trauma
 - OB mannequins (not like Veronica that requires training to use it; something more simpler)

- Summer Schedules
 - Aladtec – Discussed Midterm and Finals dates for EMT
 - Medic Summer Project - Group/Squad Project:
 - Create and record a instructional or "how-to" tutorial video of themselves working an assigned medical emergency (neonate, pedi, ob and/or trauma) in a scenario setting.
 - The scenario should start off with the assigned medical emergency and progress to a cardiac arrest patient to show competency in both disciplines.
 - BLS and ALS assessments, recognition, procedures and medication administration are required.
 - We can dive deeper into the parameters of the video submission down the road.
 - We can also assign due dates throughout the semester into 4 parts to ensure work progress and completion.
 - Part 1: Submit the assigned roles and responsibilities of each member of the group
 - Part 2: Submit a script and write out the scenario and ideas to incorporate the "how-to" tutorial component
 - Part 3: Submit a "rough-draft" of the video submission
 - Part 4: Submit final submission
 - N. Collier medics, Ben, and Christine to attend finals at the Lee Campus.
- Application and course fee increases were submitted - The increase in course fees will support raises for our clinical associates and instructors. We have been struggling to recruit and retain quality clinical associates to maintain our 6-to-1 student-to-instructor ratio in the lab. This additional revenue is essential for providing much-needed compensation increases

as well as purchasing and replacing the required equipment and supplies to keep our programs running, despite operating under a limited Fund 10 budget.
