Curriculum Updates

All of last year's curriculum changes have worked their way through the system and are officially approved. Updated syllabi should be posted to the document manager by mid-July. Good to know information – the AA degree now requires two gen ed courses in each of the five areas (so we will have at a minimum two math and two natural science coursed required for each AA student) and all AS degrees now require one gen ed course in each of the five areas (so we will have at a minimum one math and one natural science course required for each AS student).
