- II. Minutes

 - Martin came and talked to us about being prepared for the HLC meeting.

- C. Curriculum Committee—Evan, Dani
 - 1. Due to Spring Break, the Curriculum Committee meeting for March, is rescheduled for Friday, March 28th at 1:00 pm.
- D. General Education Advisory Council—Jamie, Dani
 - 1. GEAC sought recommendations on a WAC proposal from the faculty senate executive committee, the English department, and GEAC. Following some discussion with administrators, GEAC decided to ask the full faculty senate for a vote of support to form a new standing committee. A standing committee could create a pathway for a permanent director position by demonstrating the need and value of a WAC position and creating data for the administration to cover. The full faculty senate voted 91% in support. Therefore, GEAC can now ask the Union to negotiate for a WAC standing committee during the contract negotiations.
 - 2. The new GEAC toolkit is under construction, with potential collaboration with Drs. Harris and Patterson.

 - 2.
