Memo: Computer Science Course Number

SCNS changed our new course number CAP 4612 (Machine Learning) to CAI 4105. This includes a new course number and a prefix shift from CAP (Computer Applications) to CAI (Computing: Artificial Intelligence). The credentialing manual has been changed to add the CAI prefix. The course has been added to Banner, and CAI was added as an acceptable elective prefix.

FLDOE requested additional updates to our general education list. They are:

MGF 1113 Mathematics for Teachers will be removed from the General Education list beginning in AY 26-27.

MGF 1131 Mathematics in Context will have an updated course description: “This course is designed to provide students with opportunities to experience the practicality of mathematics in a global society. Throughout the course, students will engage in the applications of tools and techniques of mathematics in a variety of contextual situations from everyday life. The course is intended for a wide range of disciplines and programs, but is primarily focused on programs in the non-STEM pathways. Credit is not given for both MGF 1131 and MGF 1107.”

PHI 2600 Ethics will have a revised course title, **PHI 2600 Introduction to Ethics**, and a revised course description: “This course is a basic course in philosophical thinking about morality, moral problems, and moral judgements. Assigned theories will include selections from the Western canon.”

PHT 2810 Clinical Experience II was listed as an “L” course on the proposed catalog page for the program, but was proposed without the “L” on the course proposal. PHT 2810 Clinical Experience II should be an “L” (lab) course for students in the Physical Therapist Assistant, AS Program. The course is a clinical experience and should be programmed as an “L” (lab) course. PHT 2810L is what is listed in SCNS, and it is programmed as an “L” course in the FSW Degree Audit.

The Degree Audits for students in AY 2024-25 should be updated to accept PHT 2810 in lieu of PHT 2810L in order to show the degree requirement as “met.” The course cannot be updated to an “L” course immediately because the fee schedule has already been approved for AY 2025-26. For AY 2026-2027, PHT 2810 should be updated in Banner and the Catalog to PHT 2810L Clinical Experience II. Fees for a lab course should be assessed from Fall 2026 and forward. The course content and expectations in Clinical Experience II will remain the same, but the correct fees can be assessed to the course as of AY 2026-27.

School of Education Curriculum Memo September 2025

FLDOE contacted FSW regarding two educator preparation courses offered at FSW: EDF 1005: Introduction to the Education Profession; and EDF 2085: Introduction to Diversity for Educators. The FLDOE provided an approved course description for EDF 1005 (EDF 2005 at FSW) to replace the existing course description to be updated in the Statewide Course Numbering System (SCNS). In addition, EDF 2085: Introduction to Diversity for Educators is to be deleted.

The School of Education updated the course description for EDF 2005 and developed a new topic outline and CLOs in line with that description. The department had removed EDF 2805 from the program in Spring 2025.

While undergoing QM training and review, the course learning outcomes in five HUS courses were updated to make them measurable. These courses are HUS 1320, HUS 1400, HUS 1640, and HUS 2302.

Memo: AMH 2010 Civic Literacy

September 2025 Memo Civic Literacy AMH 2010

For the Fall 2024-2025 academic year, the State Board of Education approved revisions to Rule 6A-10.02413 to add an additional course (AMH 2010 United State History to 1877) to meet the civic literacy requirement. Prior to the rule change, Florida College System institution students could not meet the civic literacy requirement through the successful completion of AMH 2010 United States History to 1877.

It is recommended that AMH 2010 History of the United States to 1877 taken fall 2024 and thereafter count toward meeting the civic literacy course requirement for students in all prior catalog years starting in 2018-2019.
