



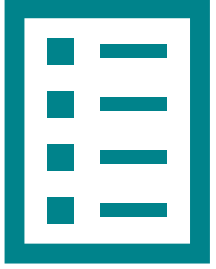

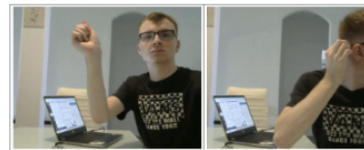

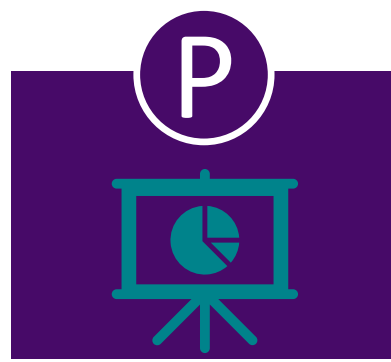

Academic Committee Updates



From SPAS Reps

The General Education Advisory Council is exploring the creation of two new **Faculty Learning Communities (FLC)** to support collaboration and professional growth. A faculty learning community is a space where faculty members share knowledge, experiences, and best practices related to a common topic or goal. At this time, we have two FLCs for you to consider:

- **FLC #1: Interdisciplinary Collaboration** – identifying opportunities to connect courses across disciplines to create meaningful learning experiences for students. For example, a biology faculty member might connect with a communications faculty member to bridge gaps/establish connections between their curricula. In this example, a public speaking student might deliver a speech using a topic from their biology class. Alternatively, a political science professor could require students to conduct election data analysis, requiring the lessons taught in their statistics class to be incorporated in the analysis. There are endless options!
- **FLC #2: Best Practices in Writing Instruction** – creating a dedicated space for faculty to share writing-specific strategies, resources, tips, challenges, and seek feedback on teaching writing in all disciplines. By collaborating on writing instruction, faculty can exchange proven techniques for assignments, explore discipline-specific writing expectations, and strengthen students' abilities to think critically and express ideas clearly. This dialogue will support both the students and the faculty.
