## Discussion

- ARRT National Comparison Scores:** FSW ranked higher in all 8 ARRT registry exam categories than the national scaled mean score. We also had a higher first time pass rate than the national average. Congratulations to all program staff who continue to provide an excellent learning experience and keep our program on top.

- Student Clinical Site Surveys:** Rendy has submitted the clinical site survey to be converted into an on-line survey. Draft survey was reviewed.


