CHANGE FROM THE I.A.C.B.E. COMPREHENSIVE BUSINESS EXAM TO THE EDUCATIONAL TESTING SERVICE (E.T.S.) MAJOR FIELD TEST (MFT) FOR BUSINESS BACCALAUREATE DEGREES. THE ETS TEST IS MORE WIDELY ACCEPTED AND GIVEN TO OVER 10,000 STUDENTS VERSUS 1500 BY THE INTERNATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF COLLEGEIATE BUSINESS EDUCATION (I.A.C.B.E.). THE COST TO THE STUDENT IS THE SAME (\$25) AND THE VALIDATION OF OUR LEARNING OUTCOMES IS STRONGER WITH A WIDER, MORE STATISTICALLY VALID SAMPLE SIZE.

PROVIDE JUSTIFICATION FOR CURRICULUM ACTION (OTHER EXPLANATORY INFORMATION):

THE COMPREHENSIVE BUSINESS EXAM CURRENTLY BEING USED IS A NEW EXAM IN WHICH ESC PARTICIPATED IN DEVELOPMENT THROUGHT THE ALPHA AND BETA TESTING PHASE AND ROLL OUT. WE HAVE BEEN USING IT FOR OUR FIRST 150 GRADUATES. 83%+ OF THE 1500 STUDENTS (AND 62% OF OUR SPRING GRADUATES)THAT TOOK THE EXAM IN THE SPRING 2011 SEMSTER WERE DEEMED "NOT PROFICIENT" ON A SCALE OF" MASTERY, PROFICIENT, BASIC

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AND NOT PROFICIENT" IN THE 8 DISCIPLINES MEASURED. THE TERM "NOT PROFICIENT" IS APPLIED IF ANY ONE OF THE EIGHT BROAD AREAS SCORES BELOW 66% OR ANY ONE OF THE 28 UNDERLYING AREAS (SEE ATTACHED). THE QUESTIONS IN THE EXAM ARE NOT AVAILABLE AND WHILE FOUR CONCEPTS ARE LISTED IN EACH OF THE EIGHT DISCIPLINES THERE IS LITTLE DOWNSTREAM ADVICE FOR AREAS TO STRENGTHEN IN OUR COURSES FROM THE EXAM. THIS IS ONE OF THE MAIN DELIVERABLES FROM THE OUTSIDE EXAM. THE MAJOR FIELD TEST FROM EDUCATIONAL TESTING IS AVAILABLE TO THE QUESTION LEVEL AND OPERATIONALLY WILL ALLOW FOR MORE IMPROVEMENT OPPORTUNITIES.
