- Financial Aid (Barry Paine, Director of Financial Aid)
 - Attendance Verification Discussion
 - Students must be confirmed before financial aid can be released.
 - Make sure students are attending the courses they are registered for (not as big an issue for traditional 4-year schools). This is not always the case with ESC students.
 - If attendance is not reported (listed as 0) for a course the student is registered for, ESC puts a disbursement hold on their account. Hold remains until resolved/ reported.
 - Any "0" reported will place a hold on the account.
 - Question: Does the student know which professor did not report their attendance?
 - Answer: Financial Aid can tell in portal and information is passed along to student in portal (if not, they can call Financial Aid and this can be confirmed).
 - Holds can be in place for a number of reasons other than attendance.
 - Barry prefers to go back and allow faculty to withdraw a student from a course if they do not attend. This is up to Academic Affairs. This is what most schools do.
 - Some students assume they will be dropped if they don't attend.
 - Changing communications with students. If you don't drop, you will have to pay for the course.
 - Online classes can be challenging to verify attendance.
 - Andrea shared our current syllabus sample text.
 - If student stops attending the day after verification, does student keep the financial aid?
 - No, instructor must enter last date of attendance in order to enter a failing grade.
 - Return to Title IV Calculation determines what student owes for not completing the course/not attending.
 - Puts a hold on student's transcript if not paid.
 - What if a student withdraws from the class?
 - Does not affect their financial aid.
 - Pell grants adjusted accordingly.
 - Students keep aid if they meet student academic satisfactory guidelines (?).
 - If not, student may lose aid in future semesters.
 - Balancing act. 10,000 students received aid in spring semester.
 - Online fraud is a concern at state level.
 - Need to implement security measures.
 - Gina Doeble and Jason Dudley looking at this now.
 - What % of students are 100% online? (Dobin and Kevin looking into this.)
 - Drop only a class dropped during first week of semester. Not on transcript.
 - Withdraw after the first week; student will be charged. On transcript.
 - Late Refund/ Late Drop Students apply for this. Must be approved.
 Treated as a drop.
 - Late Withdraw After official withdraw date in academic calendar.
 - Banner enhancements coming to help monitor student academic progress.

- Enrollment status and eligibility determined when looking at courses that count toward their actual program only (after 24 general electives). Courses must fit into the academic program.
- Lab fees are included in financial aid (tuition and fees).
- Looking at budget for online students (comes back to status as "online" student).

Dobin's Updates

- FDLC Issue with out of state students has returned.
 - Registration must identify out of state students and not allow them to take online courses.
 - May affect military students.
 - Dobin meeting with Jason Dudley and Mark Lupe to discuss how this will be handled.
 - Contact states of existing students to see if they can be grandfathered in.
 - DOE made the ruling. Ruling was challenged.
- FDLC Dobin asked for help developing a contract for textbook adoptions with publishers.
 - Adoption period (availability of books/editions).
- Textbooks
 - Dr. Harrel may allow all FT professors to pick their own textbooks.
 - Academic standards committee is also reviewing textbook adoption COP.
- Dean's Update (Mary) -- Mary will not be present and did not provide any updates to share.
