Operational Objectives:

1. The Safety Committee will take meeting minutes of all meetings.
2. The Safety Committee will work collaboratively with all College departments involved in health, safety, and/or security concerns, such as the Nursing Program, College of Allied Health Services, the Facilities Department, the Public Safety Department and Risk Management.
3. The Safety Committee will review accident/incident reports to identify any trends and make recommendations.
4. The Safety Committee will research and recommend safety training and health education programs for all members of the College community.
5. The Safety Committee will review of all campus safety procedures and make recommendations.
