WEEDING PROJECT UPDATE

June marked the first month that the Rush librarians began a targeted weeding project. Using an ALEPH generated report that shows the title, date of publication, and number of times the work has circulated, the librarians began weeding starting with the "Z's" and have made progress through TF25.u5 K53 1987. The library assistants asked that weeding start in the "Z's" so that they can start compressing the collection to meet the goal of removing two runs of shelving in order to create more student study space. As July begins, more librarians will be scheduled for weeding days.
