Field of Flags in the Taeni Hall Lawn:


Each flag represents 10,000 victims of the Holocaust (6,000,000 Jewish victims; 5,000,000 non-Jewish victims)

The display is on loan from the Holocaust Museum & Education Center of Southwest Florida


Poster Display in Building "U" Lobby:
