Dr. Saundra McGuire is the Assistant Vice Chancellor and a Professor of Chemistry at Louisiana State University. She has presented her widely praised workshops at over 100 colleges and universities, to thousands of faculty and students from diverse economic backgrounds, at different developmental levels, and with varying learning style preferences. \*Attendees of Dr. McGuire's workshop will receive credit for "Critical Thinking."

Participants may attend all three sessions or any combination. This will allow some departments to "switch" participants to ensure coverage. Eileen will send a "Save the Date" message. Rudy will set up the registration before the message is sent. The True Colors Workshop will need to be attended "in person." Rudy will check with Harlan Cohen and Dr. Saundra McGuire to see whether or not it is appropriate to attend their workshops via teleconference.

III. Updates TLC: Rudy Moreira shared that currently the Summer Institute is the only scheduled training. Eileen has asked Dr. Wright to support summer contracts to allow faculty to deliver trainings across campuses over the summer. Dr. Wright has indicated support for the summer trainings and he has approved offering contracts. Eileen is awaiting response from faculty. 83 faculty have completed all 10 Cornerstone Training Modules and 47 Staff/Administrators have completed the 5 required modules (with many of them completing all 10). Therefore it may not be imperative to offer all 10 modules over the summer, but we will try to offer many across campuses to continue the interest and provide updates to those already trained.
