- 1. Board of Trustees Meeting
 - a. President Allbritten will discuss the letter recently received from Gov. Scott
 - b. Six questions were presented in the letter and they will presented for discussion at the meeting

2. 2017-2018 Budget

- a. Dr. Stewart provided a brief update on the budget process taking place in Tallahassee
- b. We hope to have budget information in place prior to July 1
- c. The vice presidents will be off campus tomorrow for another budget meeting
- d. Dr. Stewart will provide a budget update as information becomes available and at the next meeting

3. Curriculum Processes

- a. Overall the process went well
- b. This academic year was busy and there were many changes
- c. Curriculum proposals: December 2017 meeting will be the last opportunity for review; proposals need to be submitted no later than November in order to provide sufficient time for reading and processing
- d. If curriculum changes impact multiple disciplines, time has to be allowed for awareness and discussion
- e. Pertinent faculty, coordinators/chairs, and deans need to be available at Curriculum Committee meetings for discussion, questions, and issues that are brought forward



- f. Sub-C proposals that were recently submitted to SACSCOC should receive answers soon
- g. The Airframe Program (SoBT) will require a Sub-C prospectus
- h. The proposed B.S., Interdisciplinary Education (SoE) will need to have workforce data that supports the need; also need to have conversations with pertinent FGCU personnel (i.e., Provost and College of Education
- 4. College Operating Procedures (COPs)
 - a. Dr. DeLuca and Susan Bronstein are continuing their review of the COPs
 - b. Practices were reviewed along with whether or not each COP was needed if another governing document exists
 - c. Changes made to the CNA have been applied to the respective COPs
 - d. Proposed COP changes, deletions, and keeping as-is were reviewed

5. BANNER Changes

- a. Dr. DeLuca will follow-up with the deans on how "Contact, Lecture, Lab, Other" corrections will be made in BANNER
- b. Changes will have no effect on faculty pay or load hours for School of Health Professions
