#### • Information Items:

- Accommodation Letter update—If you receive an accommodation letter for a student in one of your classes from the Adaptive Service's office, as of now it will include a class schedule at the end of the letter, so it will be easier for instructors to see which one of their classes the student is registered for.

  Faculty Senate is also planning to send out a more college specific survey in October.
- Course Cancellation COP- new COP requires a minimum enrollment of 15 (instead of 12) students for a class to run without special permission. The provost intention is to be flexible and not cancel necessary classes with low enrollment. Please let Martin Tawil (<a href="mailto:mtawil@fsw.edu">mtawil@fsw.edu</a>) know if any such necessary courses have been cancelled by your dean. It was also noted that the upper cap on some courses had been raised without warning. Faculty senate plans to make a proposal that deals with enrollment caps.
