



If you are receiving this email, you recently indicated you would like to receive more information on Campus Recreation at FSW. My name is Lisa, and I am the Fitness and Campus Recreation Coordinator at FSW.

Campus Rec looks to provide students, faculty, and staff fitness and recreation opportunities at the college. Our goal is to help those who participate receive the tools they need to live a healthy and active lifestyle.

We have two locations within FSW:

- Lee Campus: Fitness Center located at the Suncoast Credit Union Arena
- Collier Campus: J 133

Regardless of where you attend class, as long as you have a valid student ID you can access either location for your free gym membership. Additionally, we offer virtual programming including weekly yoga classes and workshops.

Some upcoming Special Events and programming include:

- Weekly <u>HIIT and Strength group fitness</u> classes (in person)
- Weekly Yoga virtual classes (see online calendar)
- Welcome to Weights online workshop: this class looks to teach participants on how to programming their strength training workouts based on their goals and needs

Thank you for your interest in learning more about the many financial aid opportunities at FSW.

The Office of Student Financial Aid is here to help you pay for college tuition and related expenses so you can stay focused on earning your degree.

Did you know that 70% of FSW students graduate debt free? With hundreds of FSW scholarships available and access to federal financial aid funds, you too may be able to graduate debt free.

How do you find out what you qualify for?

If you haven't already, to apply for federal student aid, you will need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at FAFSA. Students and parents will need an FSA ID (account username and password) to sign the form online. You can create an FSA ID in advance or while you fill out the FAFSA form at FSA ID. Be sure to include the FSW school code 001477. Types of financial aid you may be eligible for include:

Federal Grants: Money that doesn't have to be paid back

Federal Work Study: Money earned through a job on or off-campus that doesn't have to be repaid.

Federal Student Loans: Loans that accumulate interest and must be repaid

Scholarships: Gift aid that is awarded based on several factors including, but not limited to, merit, financial need and donor-designated criteria. Once you complete the FAFSA, we strongly encourage you to apply for our FSW scholarships at Scholarships Completing this one application puts you in consideration for all of our FSW scholarships.


