- 2. SAC Bylaws Changes to our FSWC SAC Bylaws were approved unanimously by all SAC members present.
- 3. Minutes from the 10-8-20 SAC meeting were approved unanimously by all SAC members present.
- 4. Innovative Learning Plan Discussion/Feedback Several parents shared that it is difficult for our traditional students to participate in remote learning. They shared that there were many frustrations last Monday when the district closed and we moved to fully remote learning. They also felt that not all teachers made themselves available to students during the school day. One parent shared that her daughter struggled during a quiz and was afraid to message her teacher on Remind because then it shows that she has her phone out during the quiz. An example was shared that graphics would not load so the student was unsure how to resolve the challenge. Mrs. Wier shared that students using an Apple computer must download Chrome because Canvas works best in Chrome as the browser.
- 5. Student and Staff THANK YOU to SAC members Michelle Wier shared how much the staff at FSWC appreciates the cookies, breakfast and lunches from SAC. They feel very appreciated by our SAC parents. Lynn Scarsi (now known as the "Cookie Lady") is going to provide cookies again for staff for the holidays. Jennifer Carrico mentioned that she is going to contact Mrs. Wier to arrange a date and luncheon for staff before winter break. Previously, another SAC parent, Mary LeDuc, wants to provide a lunch by Monty's before Thanksgiving break.
- 6. Volunteer Hours/Community Service Project Discussion/Ideas The group discussed community options they know about such as parrotoutreachsociety.org, billiongraves.org, and the Animal Welfare League. - 4. Mrs. Platt sent an email asking for volunteers and donations. Several SAC members have already responded and volunteered to help and water and chip donations are abundant.
- 5. Discussed senior events and updates. We will be having a live senior awards event (still looking for a large enough venue), GradBash at Busch Gardens on 4/23, and Commencement at FSW Suncoast Arena on 5/1. We are not able to provide seniors with a prom event due to the social distancing requirements by the college. Seeking the help of parents to consider having a parent sponsored prom. Mrs. Sukennikoff and Ms. Enberg will begin calling different venues (Isles Yacht Club, Arcadia Barn, Carmelo's, Events Center, etc.). They want to help. The idea was discussed that we (school) could sponsor a senior dinner and then the parents could sponsor a prom immediately following the dinner.
- 6. Quarter 4 Instructional Delivery Changes Discussed our decision that we would like all Hybrid students to return to a Traditional (five days per week) instructional schedule. We are currently serving approximately 25 freshmen and 25 sophomores through the Hybrid model; therefore, there will be 25 additional students in the building each school day. We believe increased cleaning and disinfecting, facial coverings, and social distancing are the largest influencers in keeping our COVID-19 cases so low. To date, only three positive cases among students and staff have been reported here at FSWC. We will not be offering remote Zoom sessions throughout the school day. Any student with an excused absence can access all coursework through Canvas and MathXL and make up any quizzes or tests when they return to school. Our Fully Remote students will continue to have access to remote instruction through the remainder of the school year.
